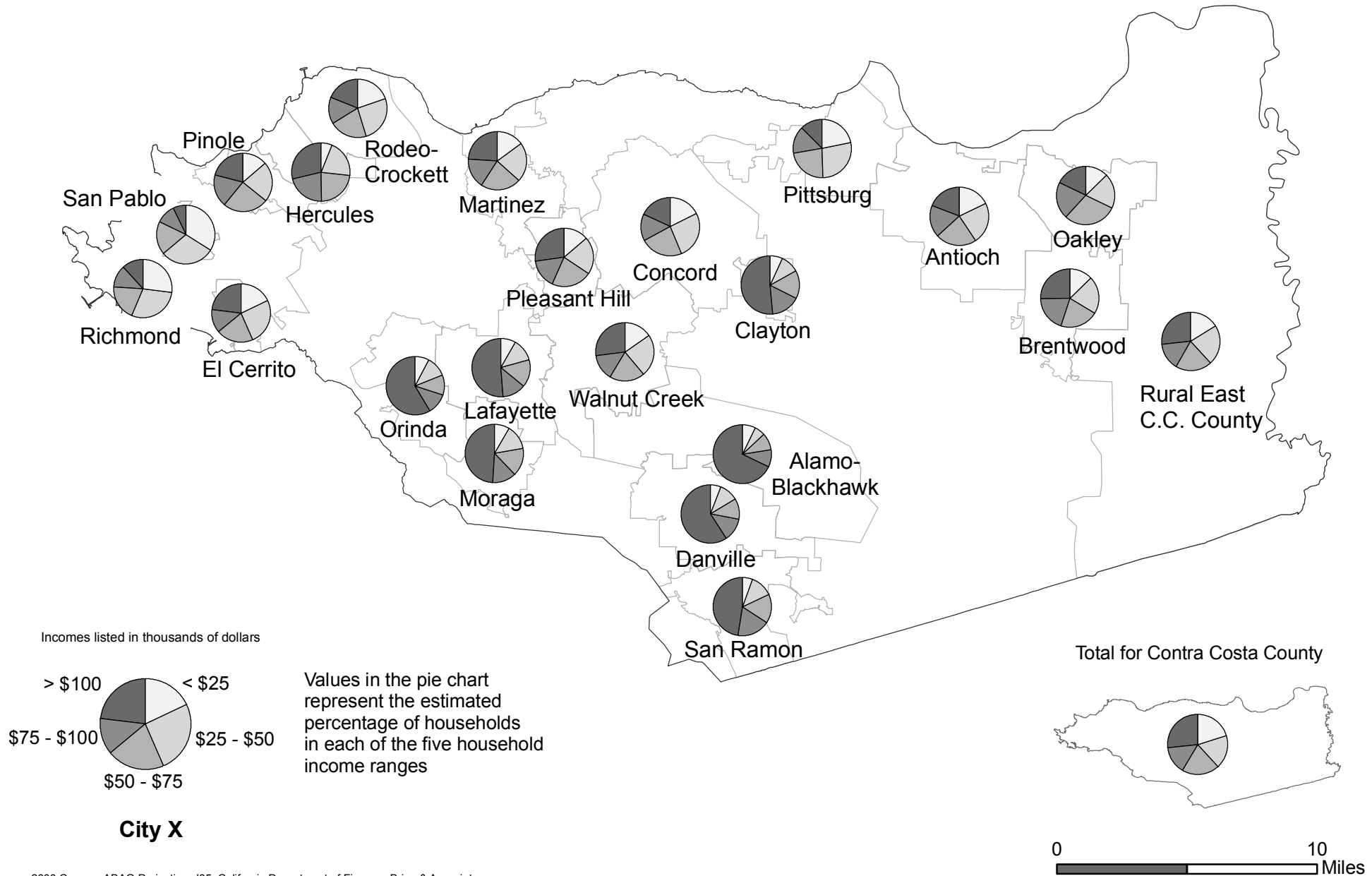
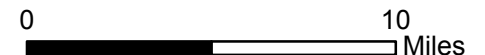
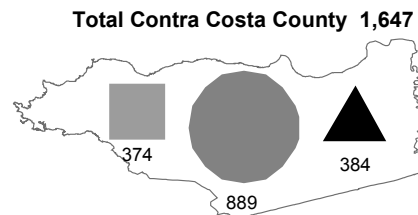
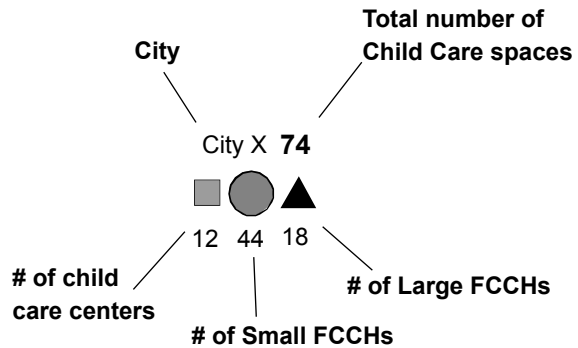
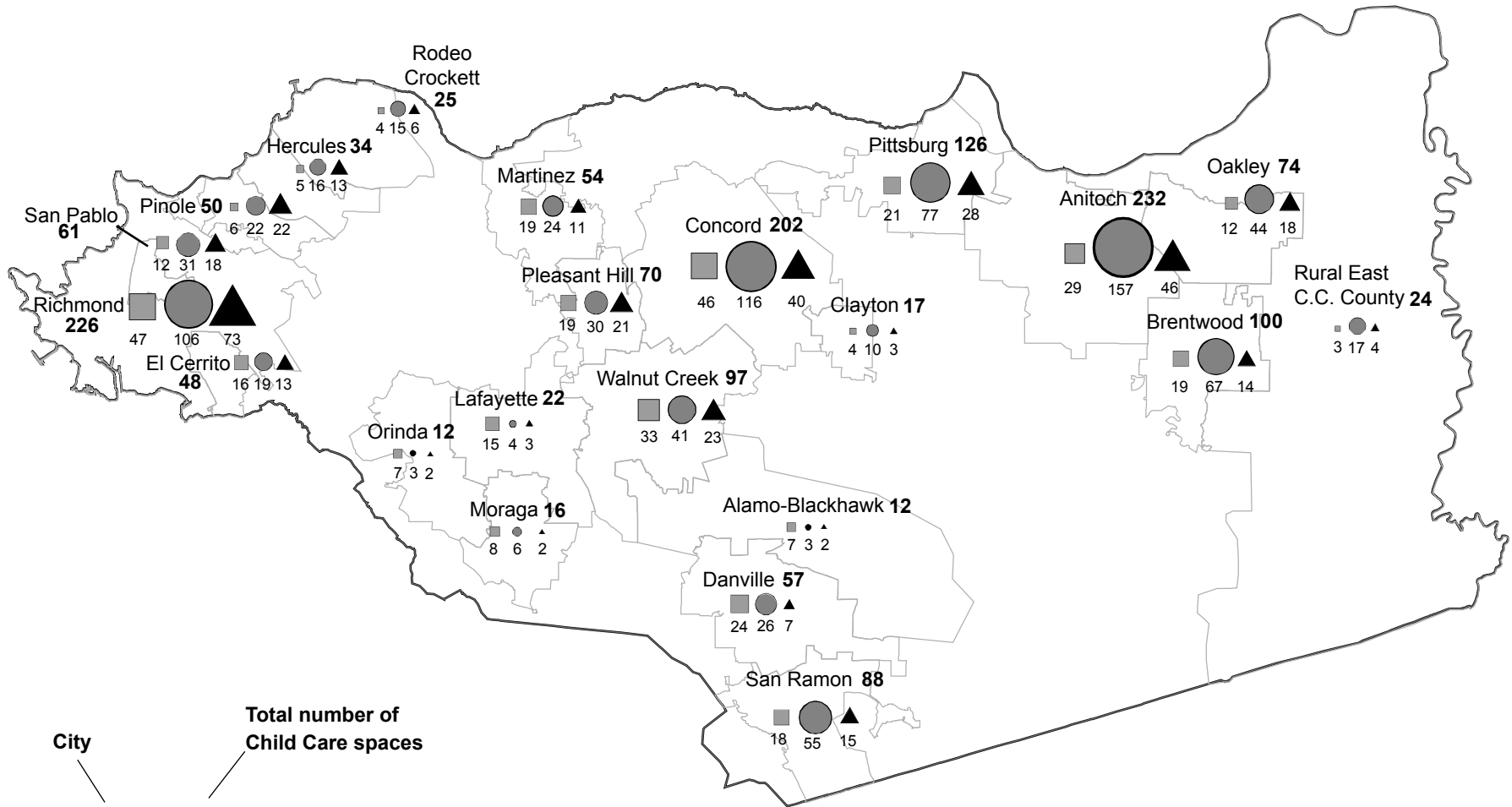


# Figure 5: Households by Household Income Range 2006 by City



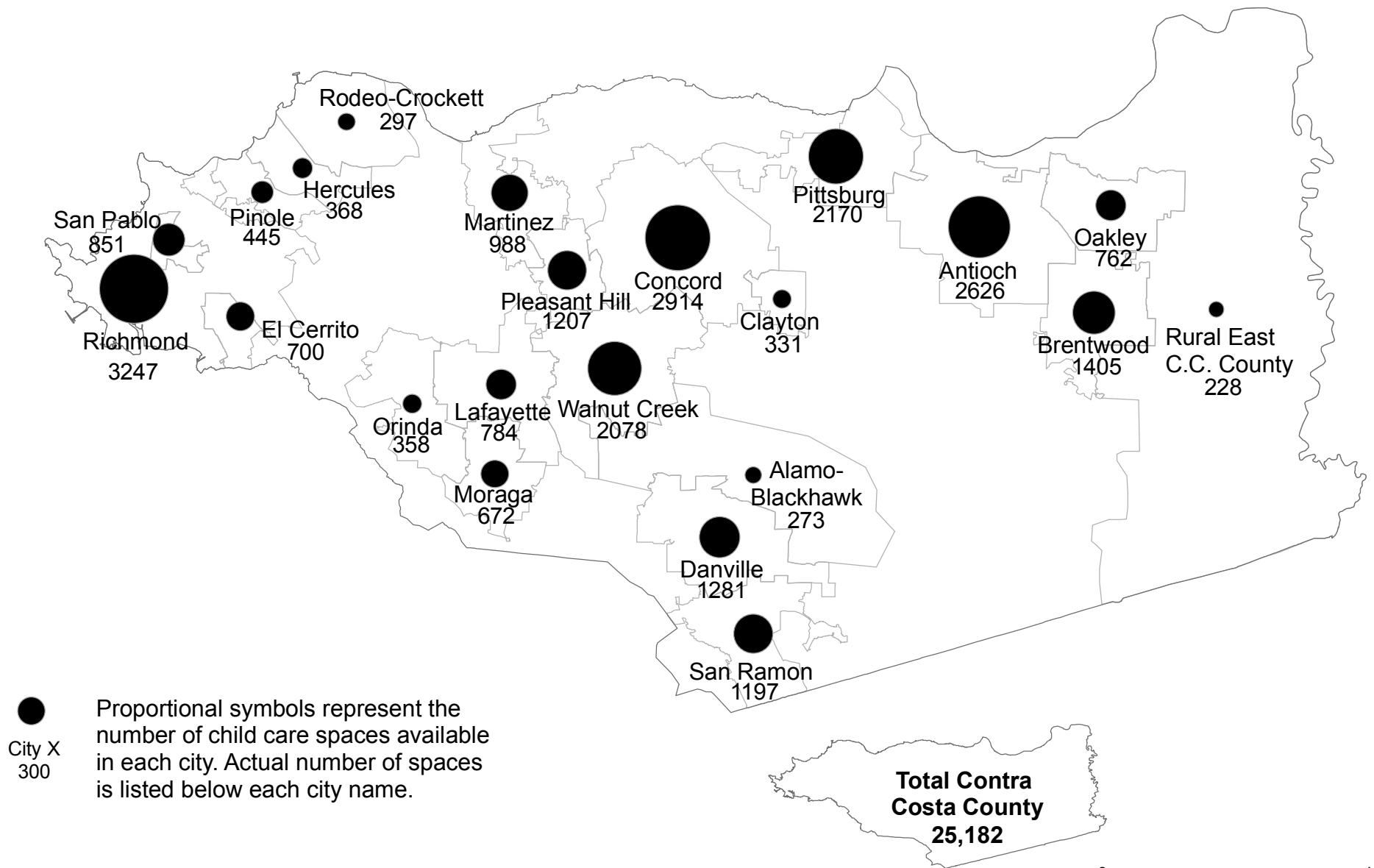

Figure 6: Child Care Providers by Type by City as of 2006



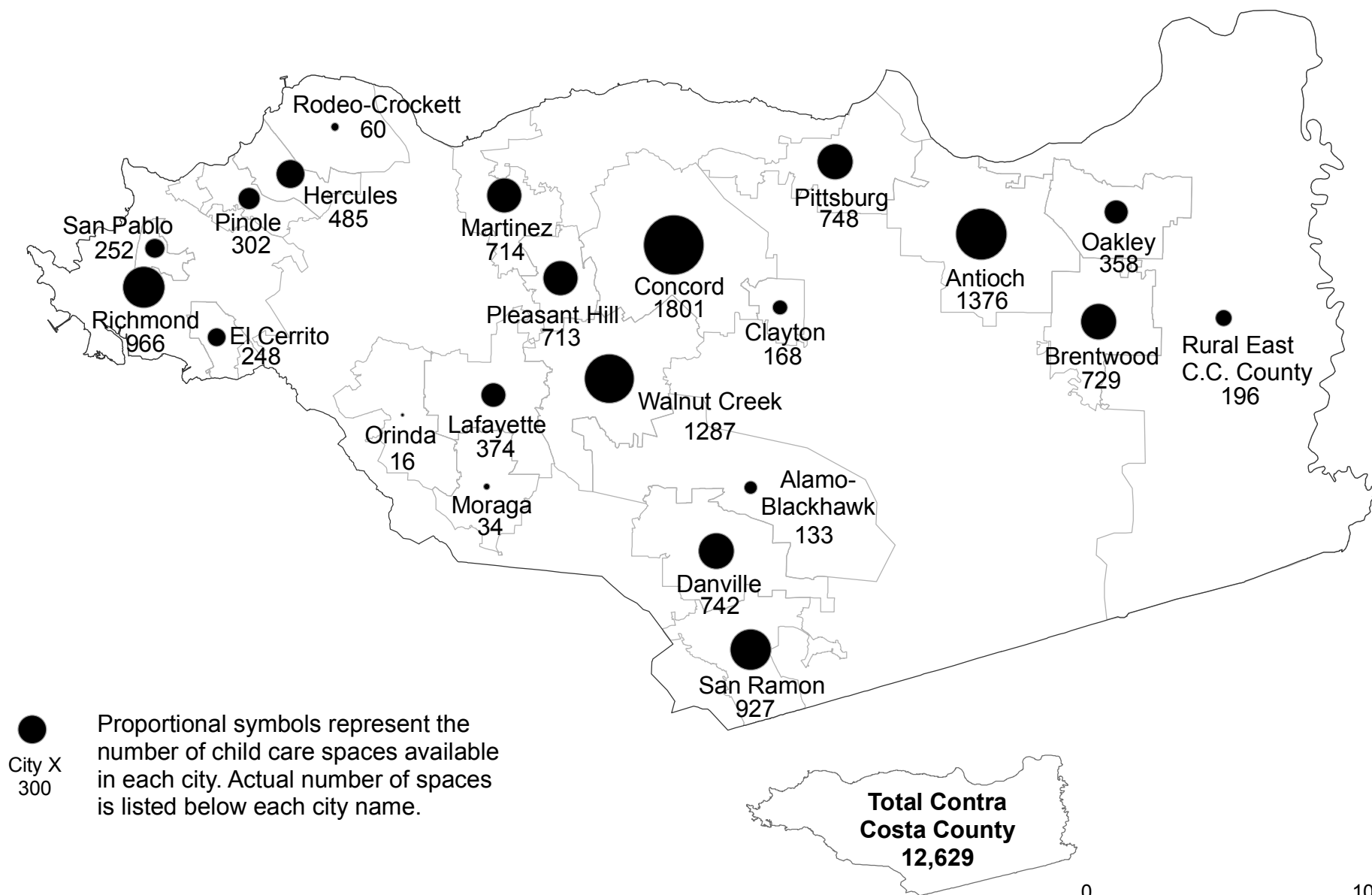

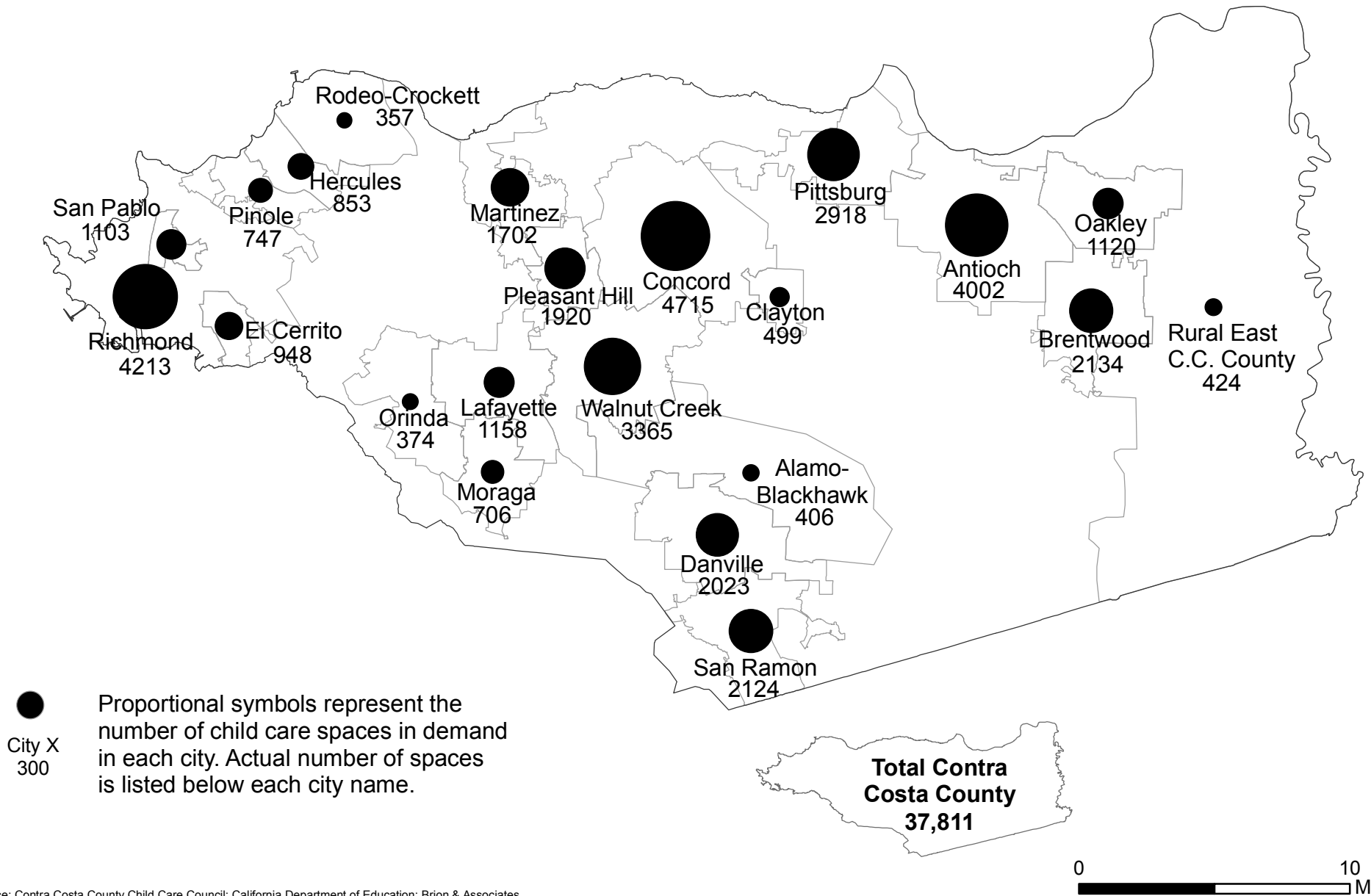
# Figure 8: Supply of School Age (6 to 12) Child Care Spaces by City as of 2006



● Proportional symbols represent the number of child care spaces available in each city. Actual number of spaces is listed below each city name.

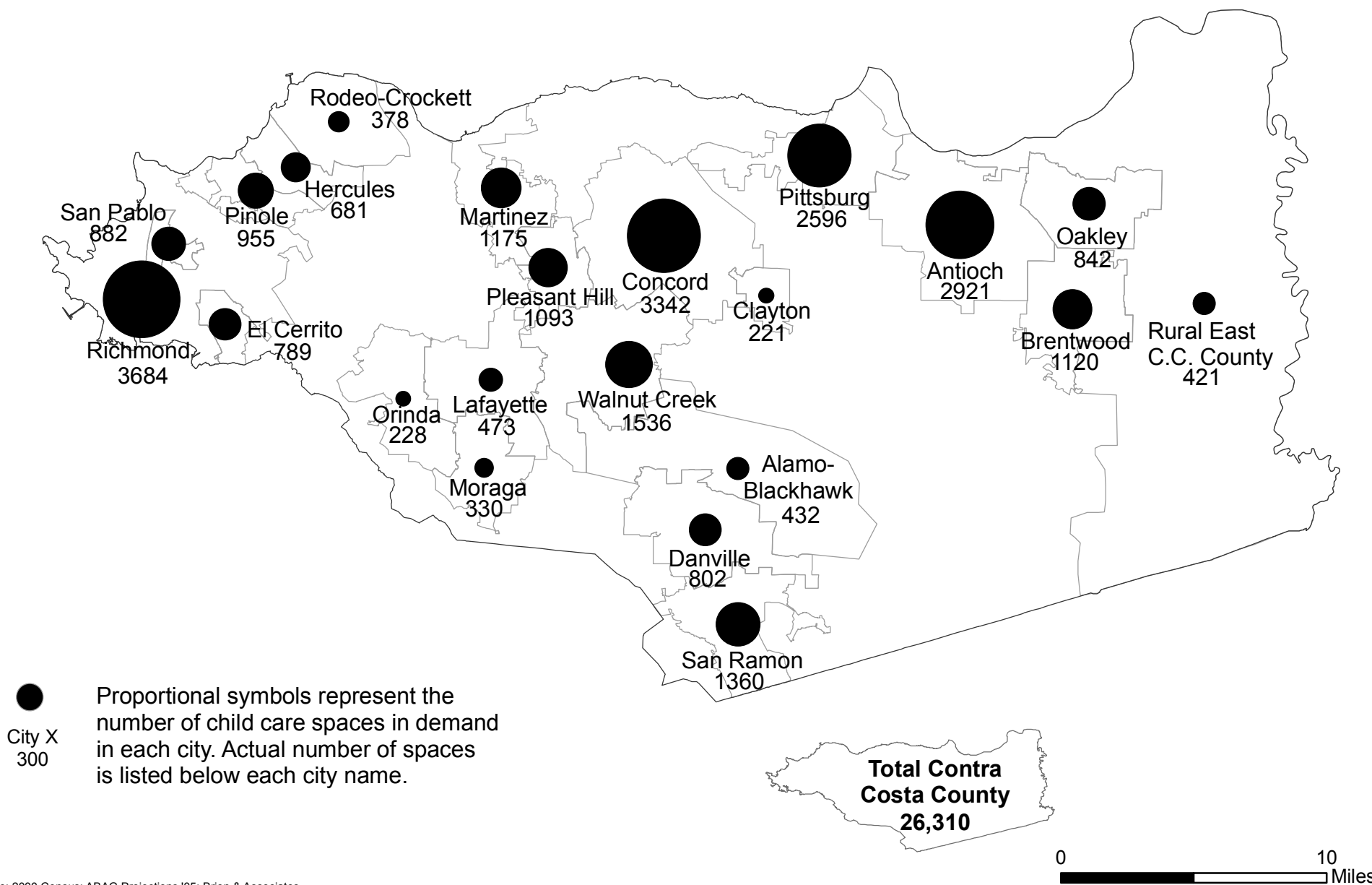

# Figure 9: Total Child Care Supply (0 to 12) as of 2006



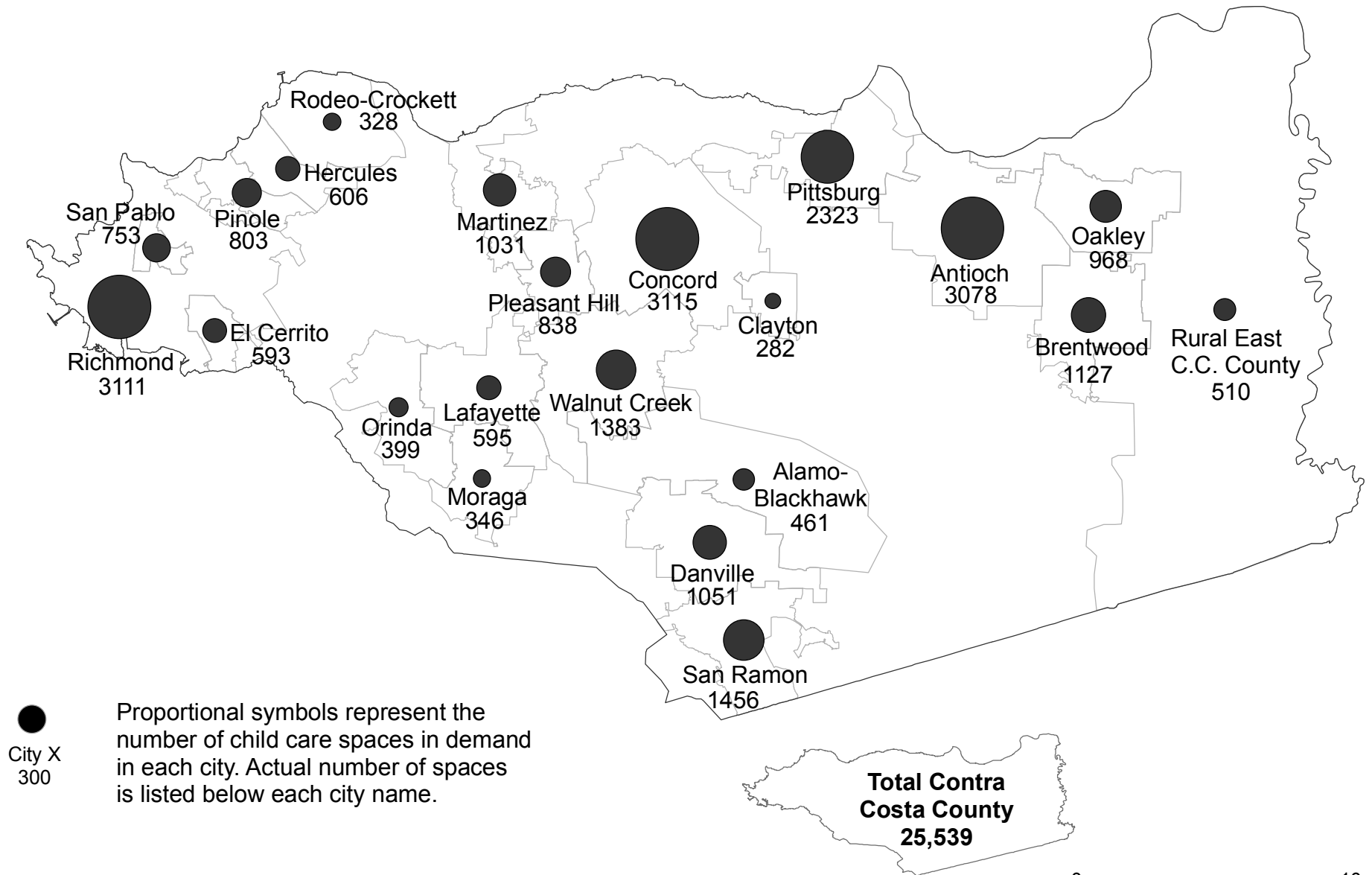

# Figure 10: Child Care Demand For Infant and Preschool (0 to 5) by City as of 2006



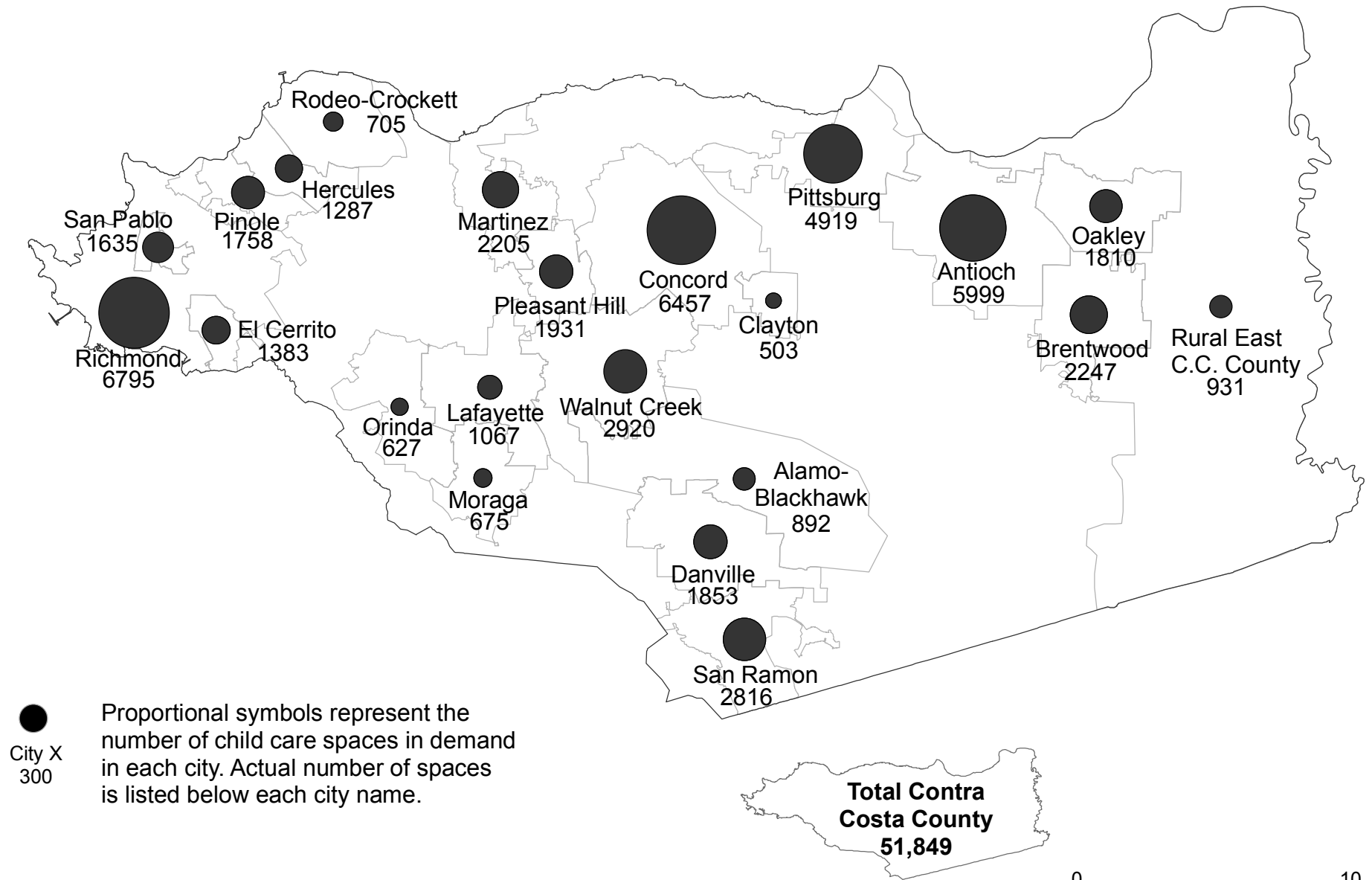
