Purpose of DAC

- Lindy explained that since the Court Schools receive Economic Impact Aid (EIA) funds, we are required to convene a district level committee to provide advice and suggestions regarding the expenditure of these funds.

Economic Impact Aid Funds

- The allocation of these funds is determined by a complicated formula based on the number of English Learners and Educationally Disadvantaged Youth. These funds are unrestricted and may be carried over year to year.
- This money has been used to fund a PT special education teacher at Mt. McKinley to assist with the SEIS data input and review.
- We received about \$35,000 the first year and \$62,000 this year. It is unclear if this will be rolled in to the LCFF in next year's budget or come as a separate categorical fund. In either case, we should have a plan for expending this funding.
- Beginning this year, all carryover funds from this budget must be posted on our website.

Suggestions by the DAC for future EIA Expenditures

- Continue to fund a PT special education teacher at Mt. McKinley
- Markers (lots of them) for the classes at the Southwest Keys (SWK) site
- An instructional assistant for the class at SWK
- Purchase Rosetta Stone
- Hire a Math Specialist
- Hire a Transition Specialist
