10:00	<p>Vaccinations for 2016-17</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Issues With SB 277: Immunizations required for K and 7th grade: children already enrolled are grandfathered in, others need to be vaccinated within a certain time frame. There is concern regarding denying the provision of service or creating an alternate placement especially for special education students. A grace period of 30 days vs. 10 days to be vaccinated currently varies from district to district. Want county to help with getting message out and making a cohesive time frame across the board for schools to follow. Also should we follow State or CDC policy? A uniform response would be beneficial, especially as students move from district to district. Lindy will follow up with other Directors to see if there is a willingness to assist with this messaging. 		Greg/Maria	
10:05	<p>District Sharing</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ajija Moore said that Maving Waves Academy has a 95.8% attendance rate. They give rewards, such as Warriors tickets for incentives. Lori O'Connor said they graph attendance rates in math classes and the students get very excited. John Angell said they have an attendance team at John Swett H.S. where 7 people at site meet 1x week with students who are chronic or moderately absent. They check in with the student 3 x week and have a binder that they use to keep track of student over time. Over half a million dollars lost due to high absence rates. Lindy Khan mentioned a great program in Riverside, CA where drug use kids attend school with core subjects along with drug abuse education. Cardenas Shackelford said overall district has improved. Wants to check into what is causing this improvement. Also told of PSA that has been running at AMC Theatres that was made by Deer Vally HS on importance of attending school.
