



Notification Letter of County Office of Education SARB Referral

Education Code Section 48262

Habitual Truant: Any pupil deemed an habitual truant and has been reported as a truant three or more times per school year, provided that no pupil shall be deemed an habitual truant unless an appropriate district officer or employee has made conscientious effort to hold at least one conference with a parent or guardian of the pupil and the pupil himself, after the filing of either of the reports required by ED Code Section 48260 or 48261.

Education Code Section 48263

If a minor in any district of a county is a habitual truant, or is irregular in attendance at school, as defined in this article, or is habitually insubordinate or disorderly during attendance at school, the pupil may be referred to a School Attendance Review Board.
