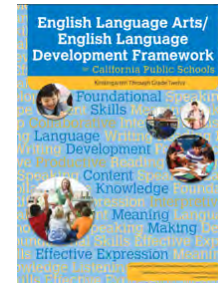

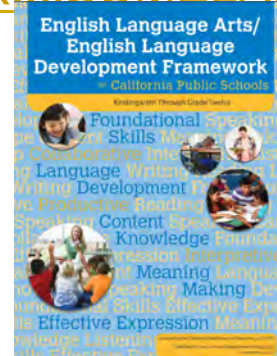
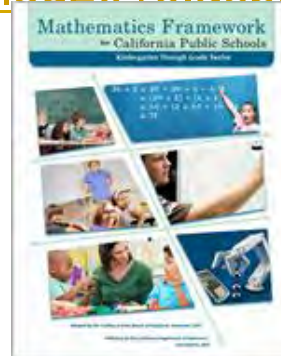
ELA/ELD Framework



- The ELA/ELD Framework Planning Committee met in June to discuss possible next steps to support framework implementation. Three main ideas emerged:
 1. Investigate the possibility of an annual “all frameworks” conference,
 2. Continue to build supporting resources (identify specific areas of interest/ audiences), and
 3. Connect/network professional learning communities. In a follow up survey, almost all participants (county offices of education, WestEd, CDE, writers/roll-out presenters) continue to be supportive and want to be involved in future activities.

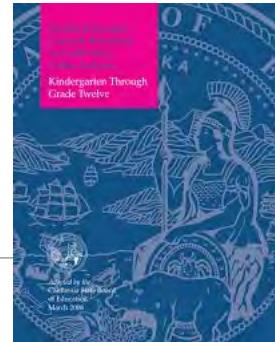


Science Framework



- 60-day public review period ended on August 29.
- Instructional Quality Commission (IQC) met on September 22.
 - Reviewed 800 comments submitted
- The SBE will consider the framework for adoption at their November, 2016 meeting.
- Roll out events for the Science Framework are being planned with the NGSS collaborative beginning next spring.

Health Framework

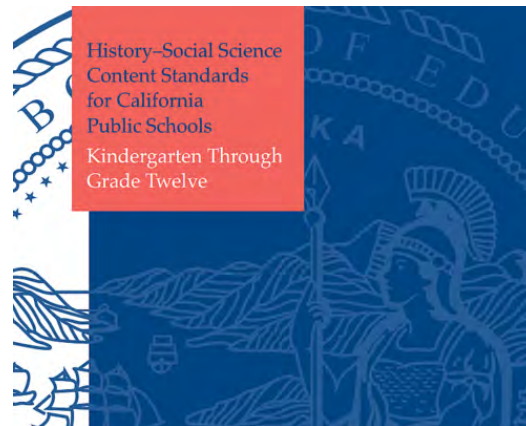


- The Health Framework focus group dates are set:
